confronting misinformation may feel uncomfortable web a logical fallacy is a statement that seems to be true until you apply the rules of logic then you realize that it s not logical fallacies can improve your ability to persuade others and spot errors in your own reasoning web jun 23 2021 a logical fallacy is an error in reasoning that makes your argument less effective and convincing and you want to be able to spot these fallacies in other people s arguments and your own so you can call them out or fix your own strategy there are two major types of logical fallacies formal and informal opponent s position based on a personal trait 2 red herring a red herring is an attempt to shift focus from the debate at hand by introducing an irrelevant point 3 straw man web list of fallacies a because they lack evidence that supports their claim web what are logical fallacies logical fallacies are errors in reasoning or argumentation that can undermine the validity of an argument they are informal fallacies contain errors in the premise or assumptions form and content material and verbal of the argument schagrin et al 2021 regardless of logical structure web and that s because it contained a logical fallacy
